Omega Nu's **Ducky Derby Fundraiser** held at Harvey West Park is **the premier Spring Event of Santa Cruz County**, drawing on a very large family crowd from Santa Cruz, Scotts Valley, Capitola, Aptos, San Lorenzo Valley, Watsonville, Monterey, and San Jose. An admission-free event, the day features carnival games, food, music and the highlight of the event, a series of rubber duck races "swimming" down a specially created waterway. Last year, with the help of wonderful supporters like you, the Ducky Derby raised net proceeds of over \$63,000 and returned 100% of the net proceeds, along with net proceeds from other fundraisers and donations, back to the local community in the following ways:

**\$70,900** in Scholarships to 46 students from our public high schools, Cabrillo & UCSC

**\$40,200** in Donations to local families, individuals and charities

**\$20,000** presented to teachers from our "Funds for Fundamentals Program" for their out-of-pocket classroom expenses
